

# Year 8 Latin C.E. Revision, Summer Half Term 2010



You should take home the following for revision

1. Your CE topics checklist

Work through this, ticking the topics as you learn them and highlighting those points which you don't understand. You should ask your teacher about these points after half term.

If you have lost your checklist, print a new copy from Cyberlatin. It can be found in the grammar booklet (last two pages). Remember to print the correct CE Level!

2. The CE vocab list

Try to learn as many new words as possible during the break.

If you are taking Level 2, make sure that you have BOTH the Level 1 and Level 2 wordlists. Level 3 candidates should also ensure they have a copy of all three wordlists.

3. The Greek myths booklet

Try to learn as many unfamiliar stories as you can. The essay question is a great way to gain some easy marks. Don't waste this opportunity! Revise them thoroughly!

4. The CE Grammar Booklet (Level 1 ,2 or 3 as appropriate)

Read this through carefully, a little every day. It is a simplified version of everything you need to answer the grammar questions. Mark anything you don't understand and ask your teacher about it after half term.
